6. Student Supports

Housing	Exchange students can choose to stay in our dormitory or off campus on their own.
Airport Pickup	 Free airport pickup is provided to students who arrive within designated period. There are two airports – Incheon and Gimpo Airports. Please, make sure to arrive at the airport before 3 pm on a designated period in order to use this service. * Please make sure to send a scanned copy of your flight ticket to <u>sunae_01@kw.ac.kr</u> 2 weeks before the arrival date for reservation of the airport pickup service.
Buddy Program	Students can apply for buddy program within 1~2 weeks after the arrival. Purpose of buddy program is to help the new students (foreign) get used to the campus life in Korea and connect with Korean students to exchange and experience new culture.
Campus Facilities	International students can use various campus facilities such as: KLAS System, Library, Ice Rink, Basketball court, Futsal court, Computer Cafes, etc.

International Students Program	 Various programs are conducted exclusively for international students for their betterment and fun experiences during their stay in Korea. The list of international students' programs are as follows: Lunch Talk-Talk Program – This is a program that gives a chance to communicate between international office staff and international students regarding living in Korea and study life, etc. Friendship Night – This program helps to Kwangwoon University international students to have fun through various fun recreations and events while all international students gather and eat together. Cultural Experience Program – It provides opportunities to experience Korean traditional and contemporary culture through interesting programs so that students can improve their Korean language skills, deep knowledge on Korean society and culture and enjoy a satisfactory university life. International Student Club – There are two clubs, Soccer Club and Volunteer Club, which is exclusive to international students. The soccer club has a soccer meeting every Saturday or Sunday morning and they play games with teams of international students from other universities. Volunteer club carries out various volunteering activities every two months such as preparing and delivering lunches to the elderly living alone, etc. 	
Extra-Curricular Activities	Students have opportunities to join various clubs (music, photography, hip-hop dance, piano, archery, ice hockey, football, basketball, futsal, table tennis, etc.) and experience college annual festival where popular music and K-pop artists (PSY, IKON, Black Pink, Mamamoo, Jessi, etc.) perform live on stage.
